Architectural Style Stick style

The two-story cottage has beveled clapboard siding with decorative brackets at the roof line and on the front porch, both indicative of the Stick style. The gable front with rear cross gable creates a massing that is also indicative of the style. Although there are no historic photos to compare it is assumed that the original windows have been replaced with one-over-one and slider windows, and that the projecting bay above the front porch is not original.

Significant Features

- Beveled clapboard siding.
- Decorative brackets at roof line.
- Front porch with decorative brackets at the posts.
- Deep overhangs and cross gable massing.

Condition

The cottage is in good repair no issues are apparent. The overgrown bushes at the front and sides could contribute to future moisture damage.
