The two-and-a-half-story massing with a cross gable roof with deep overhangs, exposed rafter tails, the triangle window in the gable front, matching bay windows at the second floor and the deep wrap around porch with Doric columns supporting a shallow hip with exposed rafter tails are indicative of the Prairie style.

Significant Features

- Cross gable roof with deep overhangs, exposed rafter tails and triangle window in gable.
- Full width front porch with shallow hip roof with exposed rafter tails supported by Doric columns sitting on square bases with paneled sides.
- Two bay windows at second floor, rectangular window on north side at first floor.

Condition

The cottage is in good repair with no apparent issues.
