

## BELVEDERE CLUB 2019 ARCHITECTURAL INVENTORY

**Year Built** c. 1900

**Architectural Style** Prairie style

This two-story cottage with its rectangular massing and steep hip roof, deep overhangs and exposed rafter tails, along with clapboard siding at the first floor and shingle siding at the second, are all characteristic of the Prairie style. Ordinarily the porch would be limited to the front façade, but the summer resort location makes the wrap around shed roof porch supported by Doric columns appropriate.

### **Significant Features**

- Steep hip roof with shed roof dormers, deep overhangs and exposed rafter tails.
- Clapboard siding at the first floor and shingle siding at the second floor.
- Wrap around porch with shed roof supported by Doric columns.
- Exterior brick chimney on east elevation.

### **Condition**

The cottage appears to be in good repair with no apparent issues.
