

## BELVEDERE CLUB 2019 ARCHITECTURAL INVENTORY



**Site:** 135

**Historic Name** Hessy Castle

**Year Built** c. 1890

**Architectural Style** Folk Victorian

It appears that the original form of this cottage was a side gable, possibly with a rear ell, with a full width front porch that wrapped around the two-story bay placed at an angle on the southeast corner. It is likely that the part of the second floor which projects over the front porch was originally a second floor porch that was later enclosed. The new beveled siding is similar to what was previously on the cottage.

### **Significant Features**

- Side gable two-story massing with rear ell and corner two-story bay placed at an angle to the main wall.
- Full width front porch with shallow pitch roof, posts and brackets are not original

### **Condition**

The cottage appears to be in good repair with no apparent issues.
