Architectural Style Queen Anne

The two-story front gable massing with a cross gable at the rear and gable front wall dormers, along with the wrap around front porch with Doric columns are all indicative of the Queen Anne style. The beveled clapboard siding and tall narrow windows, some with a two-over-two configuration are also typical for the era.

Significant Features

- Front gable roof with cross gables at the rear and gable front wall dormers, two-story massing.
- Beveled clapboard siding, tall, narrow windows, some two-over-two configuration.
- Wrap around front porch with Doric columns and shallow pitch shed roof.

Condition

The cottage appears to be in good repair with no apparent issues.
