The north portion of this two-story cottage with the gable wall dormer in the center of the side gable roof is very close to the 1894 appearance. The vertical board and batten siding, decorative carving in the gable ends and carved vergeboards are typical for the Folk Victorian style. The first and second floor porch columns and railings have been changed to Doric columns, a common change for cottages of this era. The wrap around porch roof configuration is very similar to the original. The first-floor window and door openings have been changed likely due to an addition to the west side.

Significant Features

- Side gable roof with gable front wall dormer in the center. Decorative woodwork in gable ends and carved vergeboards. Narrow door in the center of the gable.
- Vertical board and batten siding.
- Wrap around front porch with central stair and hip roof. Doric columns and railings a later change.

Condition

The cottage appears to be in good repair with no apparent issues.
