This two-story cottage was originally in the Stick style but was later re-sided in shingles and altered with additions and a changed roof. The only two elements remaining from the 1880s cottage is the clipped gable with brackets below and the first-floor three-sided bay. The diamond pane windows, corner tower and wrap around porch have been added more recently.

Significant Features

- North facing clipped gable roof supported by brackets.
- Three-sided bay at first floor under gable front.

Condition

The cottage appears to be in good repair, no apparent issues.
