The stucco clad walls with half timbering in the gable ends and dormers of this two-story cottage with a side gable roof and gable front dormer are typical of the Tudor style. The wide decorative vergeboards, diamond paned windows, and hip roof south porch with stucco pillars and knee wall are indicative of the Tudor style. The large east side porch has had the stucco knee walls and pillars removed and a two-story porch constructed.

Significant Features

- Side gable roof with deep eaves, wide decorative vergeboards and gable front dormer with diamond pane windows and half timbering.
- Stucco clad walls with half timbering in the gable ends and diamond pane windows.
- South porch with stucco knee walls and pillars, the entrance door with sidelights.

Condition

The cottage appears to be in good repair, no apparent issues.
