Historic Name Warden cottage
Architectural Style Queen Anne

Although the decorative trim in the gable ends and wrap around front porch has changed the cottage retains its two-story steep pitch gable front roof massing that is typical of the Queen Anne style. The gable wall dormers, clapboard and shingle siding are characteristic of the style.

Significant Features

- Steep pitch gable front roof with gable front wall dormers.
- Wrap around porch.
- Clapboard at the first floor, shingles at the second floor.

Condition

The cottage appears to be in good repair, no apparent issues.
